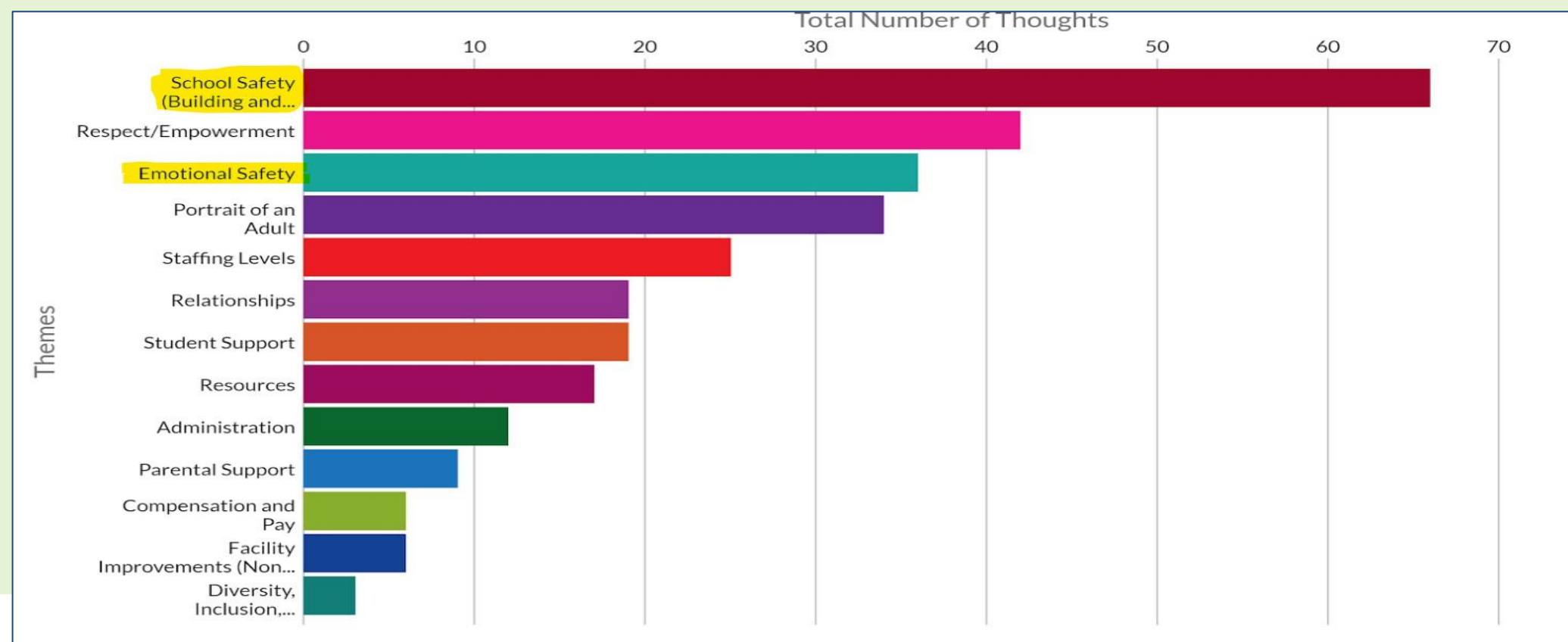
# 23g MI Kids Back on Track grant

- The MI Kids Back on Track grant funds (MCL388.1623g) will support programs provided before school, during school, after school, or during the summer. These funds are designed to address unfinished learning, get students to grade-level academic standards, provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers, or help high school students prepare for postsecondary education.
- Based on District data in ELA and Math, the application will include:
  - High dosage tutoring
  - Extended day opportunities for credit recovery including summer programs



# 31aa: School Safety & Mental Health

- Governor Whitmer and the Michigan Legislature has allocated funding for districts to carry out activities to improve student mental health and safety.
- ECS Stakeholder input surveys ranked School Safety and Emotional Safety in the top three most important issues to address:



# 31aa: School Safety & Mental Health

- Based on stakeholder input surveys, the application will include:
  - Registered behavioral therapists at four elementaries to support students in academic success
  - District portion of School Resource Officer salary to increase safety in our schools
  - Required safety equipment for School Resource Officer
  - Behavior intervention paraprofessionals to support teachers and students in academic success
